The first way to hide a column is to disable all menus in Area 1 or Area 2.

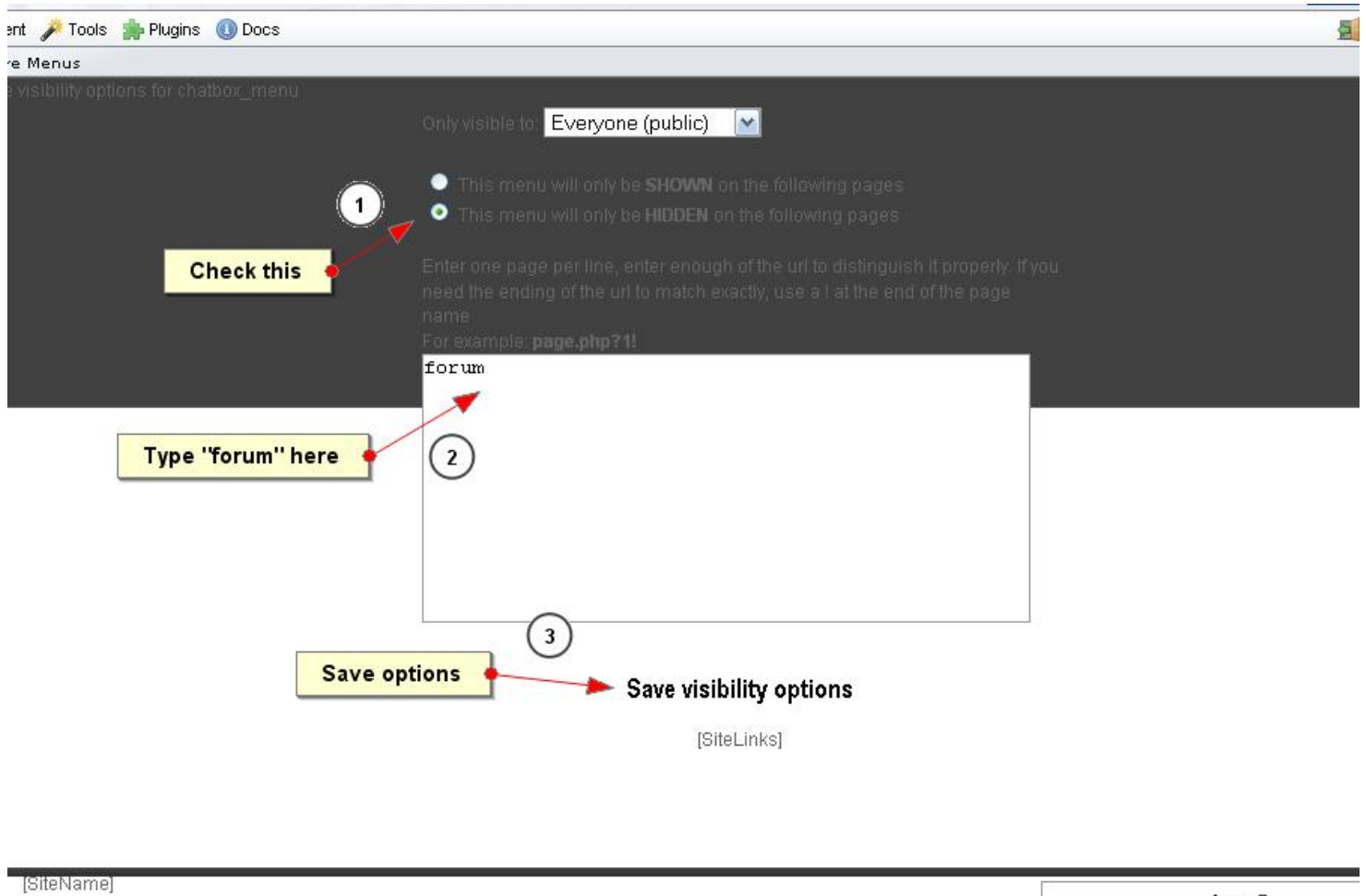
The second way is to use the visibility option in Admin -> Content -> Menus

Let say we have "Chatbox" in Area 1 and "Login Menu" in Area 2 but we need to deactivate this menus and entire column on a forum pages

1. Go to Admin -> Content -> Menus and in Area 2 choose from drop down list the visibility option for "Chatbox" menu

2. In the next screen you can configure visibility options for "Chatbox"_menu. Check "This menu will only be **HIDDEN** on the following pages" and in the text area type **forum**.



3. Save visibility options

4. Repeat for all menus in "Area 2"

5. Done! Your column is hidden on all forum pages. If you have two or more menus in this column you need to configure the visibility options for each one.

How to change Site Name

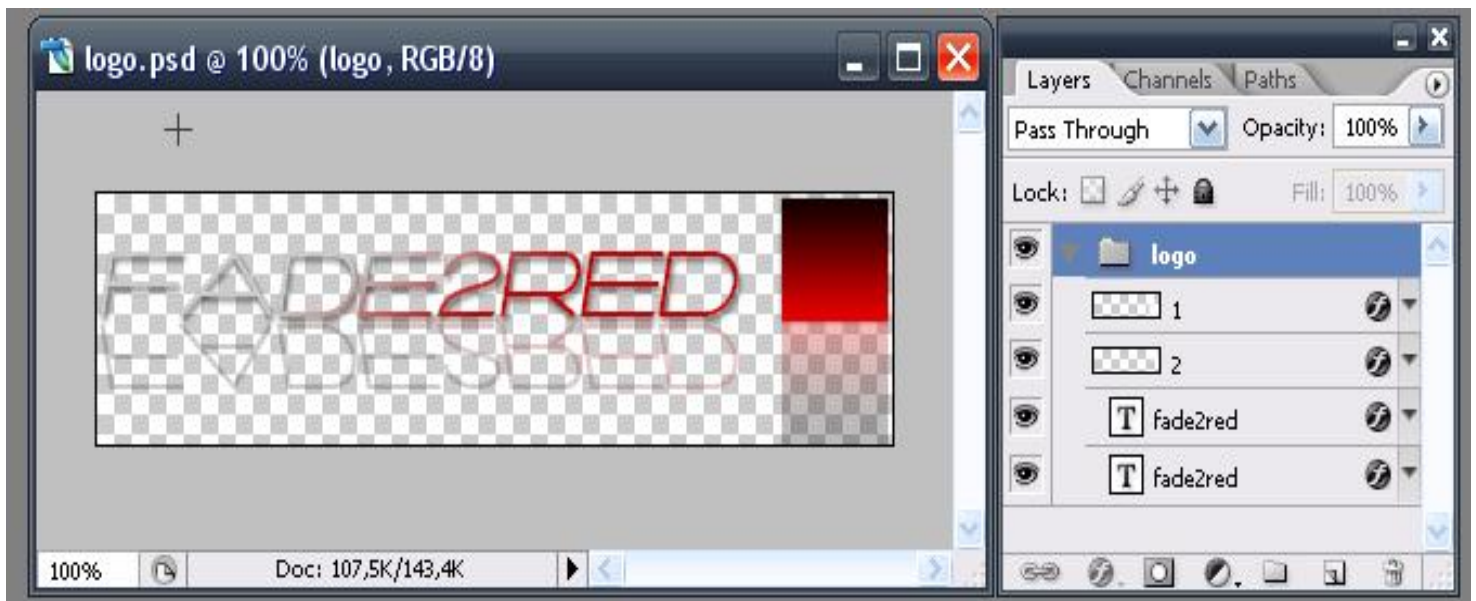
You can find all needed source files in folder "_sources" in the downloaded ZIP package.

From directory "_sources" install all fonts from directory "fonts" first

You can easily edit these two images. Use "logo.psd" file from directory "_sources". The only thing you need to know is not to resize the images, just edit their contents.

1. Install all fonts from directory "_sources/fonts"

2. Open "logo.psd" directory "_sources"



3. Double click on the first text layer. Type your site name
4. Double click on the second text layer. Type your site name again
5. When you are done choose in Photoshop **File -> Save For Web** or press **Alt+Shift+Ctrl+S**
8. Click **"Save"** and navigate to **"SITEROOT/e107_themes/fade2red/images"** and save as **"logo.png"**.
9. Done
